

I am so grateful to once again be part of our Association. Last month, several of us enjoyed attending our annual Southern Baptist Convention, which reminds us that we are "better together!" The "Cat is Out of the Bag." Thailand mission efforts are growing.

Will you lead your church to the foreign mission field?

God is moving the hearts of people from all over the world to be on mission and to be on mission in Southeast Asia. Thailand is uniquely situated and closely connects to six countries that do not allow the Gospel to be preached openly. Thailand is the "Gateway to West Mainland." By reaching Thailand for Christ, we could launch full evangelistic, church planting, and compassion



ministries throughout West Mainland – a geographic region that is widely closed to the Gospel. With God's help we can make a difference.

The first interest meeting for the March 18-28, 2024, Mission Journey to Thailand is set for July 6, 2023. This meeting is for any member of a Mississippi Southern Baptist church and especially for those located in Stone, Hancock, and Harrison counties. In this meeting we will pray together for Thailand and Missionaries serving there. We will recap the recent trip to Thailand to give you context and information about the region, security, and evangelistic possibilities. We will discuss the timeline and expectations to clarify the process and answer questions. Please stop what you are doing now and set your calendar for July 6, 2023, to take time to see if this is something God would have you and your church be involved in. Take a look on the next page to see what is happening in your Association regarding Thailand.

Associational relations with Thailand are exploding. With Crosspoint Church in Gulfport leading the charge, Lyman FBC on the ground this week, Bel Aire Baptist on the ground in two weeks (that's my team) and Michael Memorial and Big Level Baptist having sent people already, the enthusiasm and excitement is growing exponentially. Not just that, but cooperation between churches is happening. Crosspoint and Lyman FBC are in Thailand together this week. How exciting is that? You could be next. Be thinking about another church you could partner with to make the possibility of going to the NATIONS a reality.

This week I had the pleasure of meeting with Jimmy Stewart from FBC, Gulfport, and Smokey Gibson from FBC, Biloxi to talk through the possibility of jumping on board with what could be the largest overseas mission collaboration in GCBA History. Don't forget about Bay St. Louis and Wiggins FBC who are talking through what it could look like to send people from their congregations to share the Gospel with the Thai people, help teach in the Christian schools, and train pastors.

To make this happen we need cooperation.

Brian Cameron did an outstanding job asking his congregation to participate this Sunday and I am expecting many more of you have questions and want to know how to get involved. We have full-color flyers you can share with your congregation. Just send us a message and we will send you some flyers to pass out. Share the content of the flyer with your congregation or call me and I will make time to come and talk to your church about missions and missions to Thailand. Take a look at the flyer on the next page and call the office today if you need some for your congregation. God is blessing the Gulf Coast Baptist Association and is leading us to missions in Thailand.


Dear Friends,


