#### **Church Planting, Disaster Relief, and Missions Partnership**

We are one month away from asking our churches to give to the annual Bobby C. Perry Associational Missions Offering. This offering is used to provide additional funding for three specific ministry areas:

- 1. Planting New Churches,
- 2. Assisting with Disaster Relief Efforts, and
- 3. Engaging in Global Missions.



#### **Planting New Churches**

We live in the most unreached and spiritually-resistant area of Mississippi – the Gulf Coast. We have a growing population, and our church growth is not keeping up with population growth. While we need to see many of our existing churches revitalized, we also need additional new churches along the Coast.

The population of our three counties are 19,000 in Stone County, 46,000 in Hancock County, and 209,000 in Harrison county – 274,000 people. If we determined that the Southern Baptists would be responsible for just ¼ of that number (since there are other denominations on the coast), that would make us responsible for approximately 69,000 people. If you then divided those 69,000 people into our 64 churches, it means each church is responsible for just over 1,000 people. This alone tells us that we do not have enough churches to meet the population demand we currently have.

#### **Disaster Relief**

Our nation and world are constantly dealing with a natural disaster somewhere on the globe. We need more people engaged in Disaster Relief efforts. As we personally have seen the benefit of Disaster Relief efforts in our own area, I hope we can see more of our Gulf Coast Baptists trained in Disaster Relief in the near future.

#### **Missions Partnership**

And as those called to be the Salt of the earth and the Light of the world, we want to see each of our churches more engaged in missions. We look forward to ways we can draw more of us together for missions both at home and globally.

It is for these reasons that we hope you will encourage your church family to give to the Bobby C. Perry Associational Missions Offering on October 8th, 2023.
